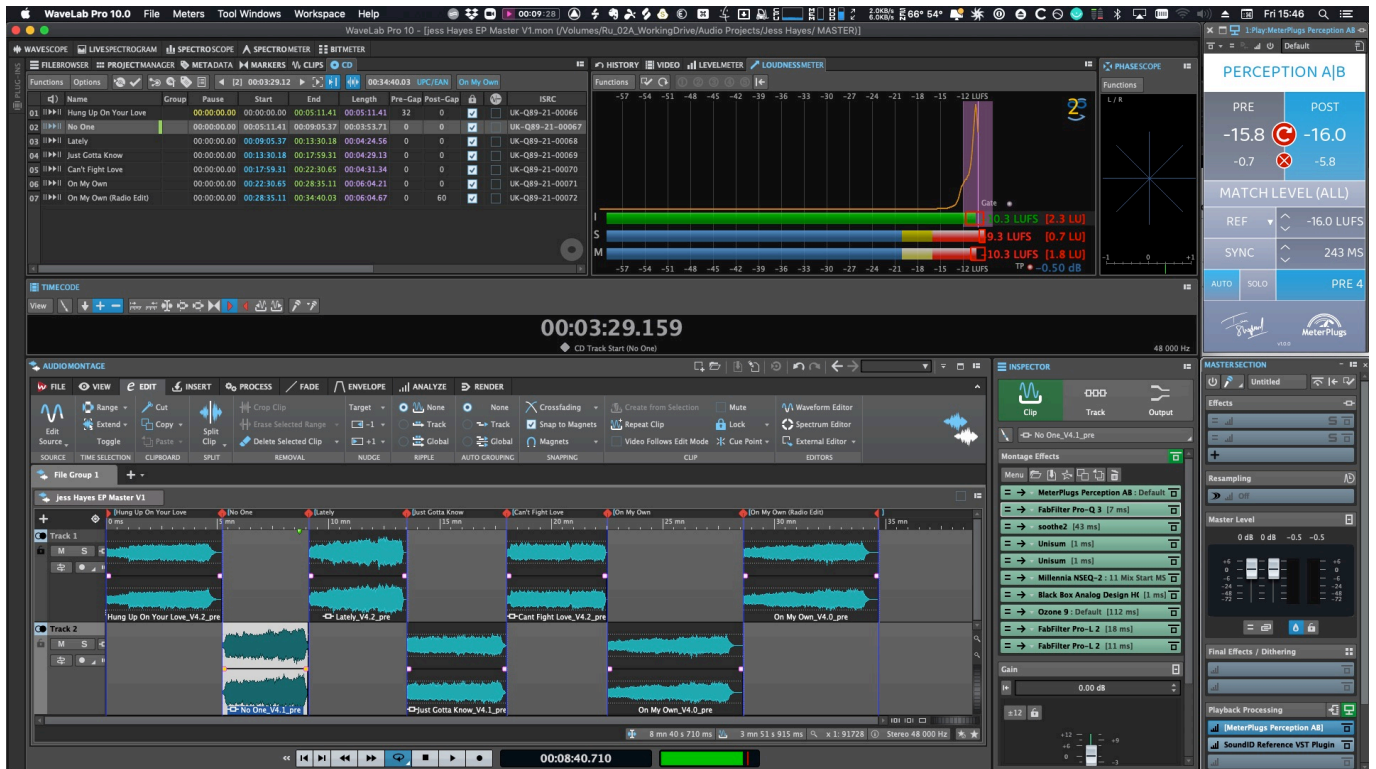

Rep. Tulsi Gabbard of Hawaii is one of 12 Democratic candidates set to debate at the University of Michigan on Thursday. Appearing at a CNN town hall Wednesday night, Gabbard explained that she would support banning "offensive weapons." "Of course, I have a different definition of what an offensive weapon is," Gabbard said. "For me, it means a weapon that is designed to cause bodily harm or death." If elected president, Gabbard said she would direct the U.S. Department of Justice to prosecute people who violate laws that make it a crime to "promote acts of bigotry and hatred." Gabbard's support for banning weapons that could be used to harm Americans is on full display in her recent campaign ads. In them, she cites her experience in battle and her military service as a justification for her proposal. On stage Wednesday, she expanded on this position, calling for a nationwide ban on "weapons of war." "What that means for me is that I want to make sure we put a stop to these weapons being sold on our streets that are designed to kill, harm and maim human beings," Gabbard said. "These weapons are not going to be used to hunt bears or deer. They are going to be used to kill people." Her position on banning these weapons has met with some skepticism among gun rights supporters, who argue that the Second Amendment protects the right to bear arms. Gabb
